### REU Site in Raptor Research

### Boise State University SUMMER 2021

The **REU Site in Raptor Research** is sponsored by the **National Science Foundation** and **Boise State University**. REU-Raptor Research is a 10-week undergraduate summer research program located in Boise, Idaho.

The goal of **REU-Raptor Research** is to engage undergraduates in biological research with university faculty and other scientists using birds of prey (hawks, owls, falcons, vultures, and eagles) as model systems.

**Eligible Students:** U.S. citizens or permanent residents attending any college or university.

In addition to the mentored research experience, participants receive (1) a \$6,000 stipend, (2) free housing in a residence hall, (3) round-trip travel to Boise, and (4) a food supplement.

**Program Dates: May 17 – July 23, 2021**
